- Paper:** Corrugated Cardboard (Brown & Colored)
Newspaper, Inserts, Coupons
Magazines, Junk Mail, Window envelopes
Brown Paper Bags
Local Telephone Books
Uncontaminated Cereal and Food Boxes – inner
Bags removed
Shoe Boxes, Gift Boxes
Soda/Beer Cases
- Metal Cans
& Glass Bottles:** Remove all caps and tops, rinse, labels can remain
Aluminum foil, washed and folded, foil take-out
containers
- Food & Beverage
Containers only:** Glass – green, brown, clear

- Plastic Containers:** Milk, Water, Soda, Juice, Food Containers
Laundry, Dish Detergent, Cleaners
Shampoo
Containers stamped #1 or #2 ONLY
- Aseptic Cartons:** Milk

CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROCEDURES

Plastic, glass, and metal containers can be placed together in bin. Corrugated cardboard must be **flattened** and cut down to approximately 2.5' x 2.5' and stacked separately - tied up with string or taped is optional. All other paper recyclables must be placed in brown paper bags or tied with string and placed on top or beside bin. **DO NOT mix loose paper items in the bin with the other recyclables. DO NOT put anything in plastic bags.**

NOT RECYCLABLE!!: ceramic dishes, coat hangers, Styrofoam, oil and antifreeze containers, glass dishes, cups and water glasses, light bulbs, batteries, prescription drug bottles, and plastic bags and film.
